# BBA 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Room, 29 Church Street Minutes

#### 1. Welcome

## 2. Administrative Tasks

- a. Motion for Approval of Minutes from September 19th 2014 meeting by Max, 2nd by Dan- Approved 1 abstain.
- b. Motion for replacing Jen Mincar- suppressed till next meeting
- c. Setting of Special Meeting for PAC in December to include Andy Hill of Desmond
  - i. Meeting set to December 16th 2014 @ 4pm-6:30pm in the BBA conf rm.
- c. Discussion on Setting of New PAC Meeting time for January June 2015
  - i. Agreed to postpone planning of new meetings until December 16th
- d. Review of City Public Meeting requirement (Nate and Diana, CEDO)
  - i. Diana spoke on Meetings Schedules being required to be made public 48hrs prior to meeting
  - ii. Minutes are to be posted within 5 days after the meeting
  - iii. Nate brought up two points that 1. Minutes from these meetings will now be public and 2. That because meetings are posted, the public may attend in the future.
  - iii. This followed up with a 5 minute discussion on the rules of meetings and possible violations with suggestions of making blog posts versus emails; to keep private emails out of public record. Google Documents was mentioned by Kelly as a place to keep collected documents and correspondences.
  - iv. Matt noted that the agenda must be circulated and sent to Diana to be made public.

## 3. Downtown Parking Team Report







- a. Nate spoke on the Portland Trip Debrief and the key takeaways Housing- Social Services- Tourism
  - i. More affordable and workforce housing
  - ii. Lower barrier Social Services
  - iii. Establish Burlington as a destination
  - iv. Major issues revolving around zoning policy and reform are inhibiting growth in Portland and Burlington should take notice of that, as well as their signage.
  - v. Portland is on par or behind Burlington on parking
  - vi. Install Cali America meters to replace on street meters as capital budget allows
  - vii. Parking is a city dept. that generates \$4million in revenue for the general fund
  - viii. Parking garages owned by the city suffer from delayed maintenance and repair
- 4. Pat Buteau gave an update on the new parking changes
  - a. Revenues from credit cards are 50% (25% in the first day)
  - b. All meters are in place and starting Monday 25, 2014 poles will be shortened
  - c. Jeff voiced concern about running meters until 10pm and suggested 7pm
- 5. Desman Presentation on Parking Findings- Kelly
  - a. Factoring future growth and assessing current operations Desman has made some conclusions regarding our city's parking including; underutilized mixed space lots, dynamic pricing and way-finding will have major impacts.
  - b. Information for the parking Zones are as follows

Zone 1	Zone 2
39% of total parking	26% of total parking
64% of total public facility parking	Balance of Public/ Private parking options







Zone 3 23% of total parking Under Utilized Zone 4 12% of total parking Less Availability

- 4 Zones providing 8,081 total parking spaces
- 1,199 total street/ curb spaces (73% metered)
- 2,825 total off street public spaces
- 4,057 total spaces in private facilities
- c. Jeff wanted to look into the underutilized private spaces for after business hour use, it was agreed upon and Nate mentioned it would be looked into.
- d. Kelly's conclusion with suggestions from Desman
  - i. Look into dynamic pricing
  - ii. Make note of underutilized spaces and zones
  - iii. Take in consideration Vermonters unique habits
  - iv. Current enforcement efforts appear effective
  - v. Alternative transportation solutions

#### 6. Discussion-15 minutes

a. Going off of the Desman Presentation open discussion supported looking into utilizing mixed spaces, changing of metered hours and way-finding to make the parking process simpler and avoid jams around Church St.
